What you need to know before your dress fitting . . .

- Be sure to plan to start fittings of your wedding dress to be a couple months ahead of your wedding date. Prom or bridesmaid-just a couple of weeks!
- Before you start your fittings, you need to have your shoes! If you want your hem correct, have those shoes at every fitting!
- Undergarments matter! If you plan to wear foundation wear (Spanx) and/or a bra, start shopping as soon as you buy your dress. As for bras, the position of the "girls" will affect the hem and waistline of your dress. If you are not sure what the best solutions are for your undergarments, your seamstress can assist you!
- Keep your fitted and pressed dress in a safe place, preferably NOT in a dress bag (so it can breathe!) Keep it away
 from animals, especially cats!
