WHAT IS A "PINCH"?

TABLESPOONS IN A CUP?

1 POUND-DRY

1 CUP-LIQUID

1 PINT-LIQUID

1 QUART-LIQUID

1 GALLON-LIQUID

APPROX. 2 1/2 TEASPOON

FOR MEASURING HERBS OR SALTS- AMOUNT GRABBED BETWEEN THE THUMB \& FOREFINGER

16 TABLESPOONS IN A CUP

16 OUNCES-DRY

8 FLUID OUNCES

2 CUPS OR 16 OUNCES

4 CUPS OR 32 OUNCES

4 QUARTS OR 128 OUNCES
${ }^{* *}$ It is important to note that you will need separate measuring cups
designed for liquid and solid ingredient measuring. There is about a one
ounce difference in volume between a liquid and solid cup

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
